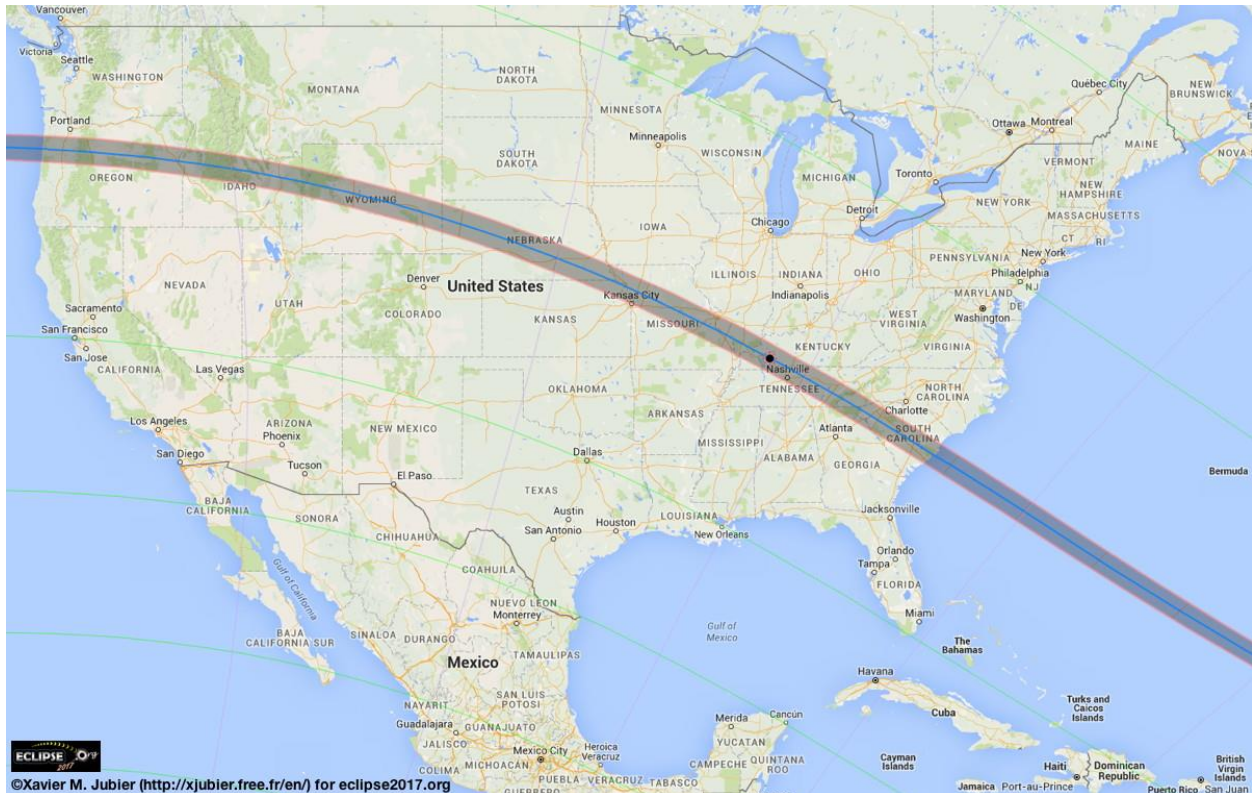


The Great North American Eclipse of 2017 8/21/17

Information for viewers in Corsicana, TX

As I'm sure you've seen in the media, there will be a total eclipse of the sun on August 21st this year. Only those lucky enough to be in the path on the map below will be able to see the moment of totality when the moon will completely block the sun's photosphere.



Viewers outside of the path, can still experience the event as a partial solar eclipse by viewing the sun with proper techniques. The following information is specific for viewers in Corsicana, TX.

Date: August 21, 2017	Start of Partial Solar Eclipse:	11:41 AM
	Maximum Partial Solar Eclipse:	1:11 PM
	End of Partial Solar Eclipse:	02:40 PM
